It is in this context that the Management of Paul George Global School

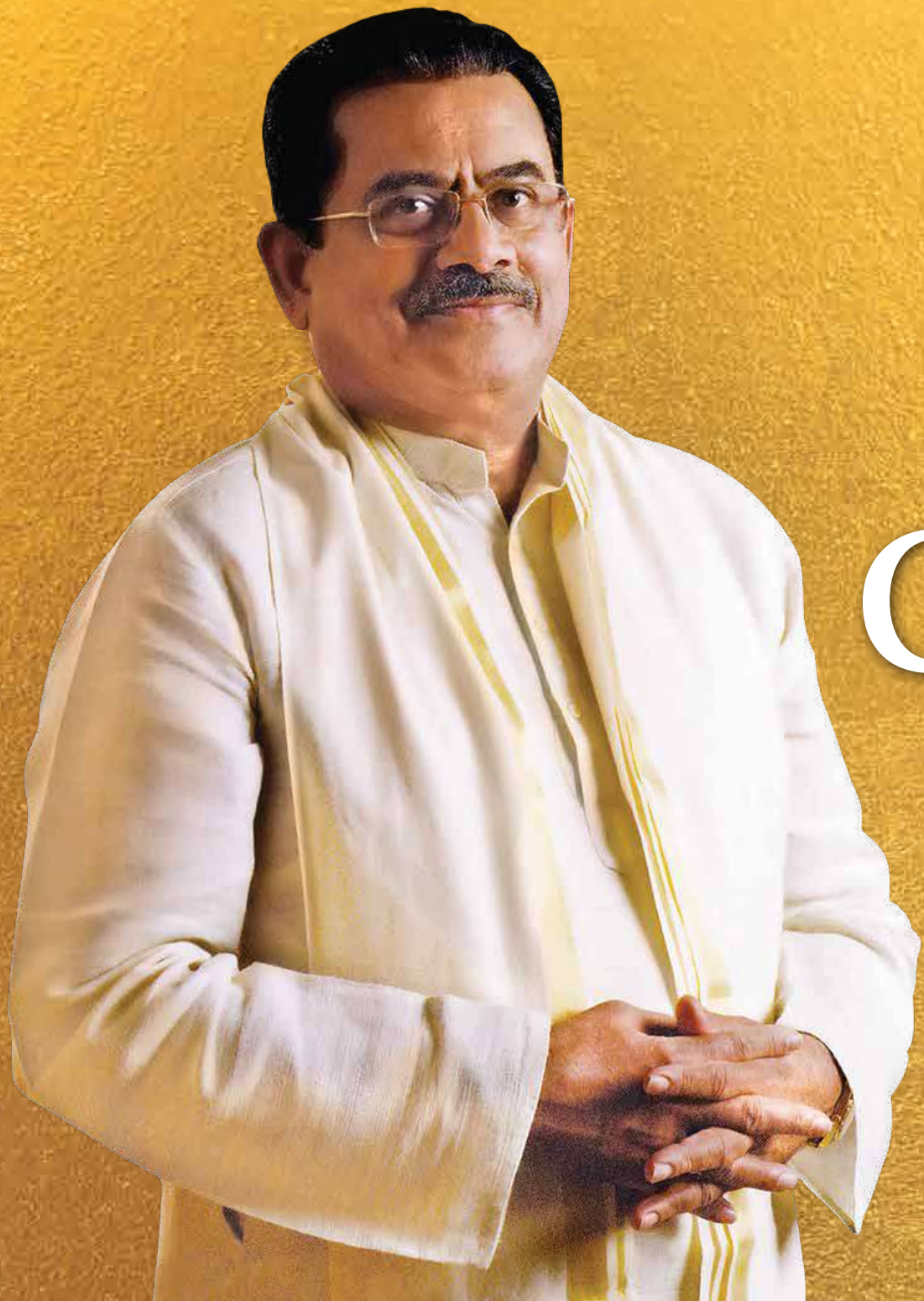
aspires to inculcate these four values of Paul M. George in every student who walks through the gates of PGGS.

# Eco-Friendly Infrastructure

The School is facilitated with a world-class infrastructure and Wi-fi enabled campus that is inspiring, eco-friendly and gives students, including the differently-abled an ideal environment for holistic learning. The academic block comprises 56 classrooms and totally barrier-free, fully air-conditioned building located around a quadrangle.

The school has decidedly adopted a green approach and has used all possible environment-friendly design techniques. The outer school walls are constructed with energy-efficient and environment-friendly Air Aerated Concrete Blocks (AAC).

In addition, the school is equipped with Radiant Cooling, also known as Thermally Activated Building Systems (TABS), to have eco-friendly, efficient and effective utilisation of energy. A Rainwater Harvesting System for active rainwater harvesting and a Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) reduce water usage by recycling the treated water for flushing and horticulture. All these eco-friendly specialities are instituted with the sole intention of developing an environmentally sustainable edifice.

The school will be 100% solar powered in the near future.

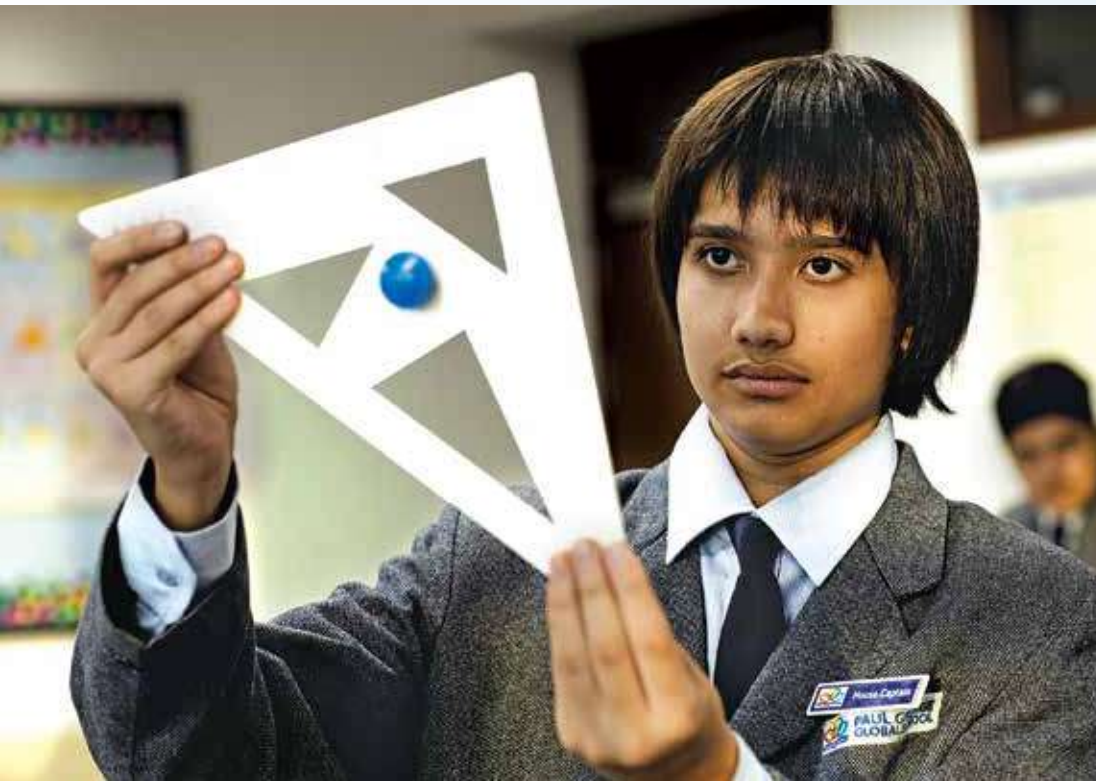


# Career Counselling and Building Careers
