Poster-Making Competition

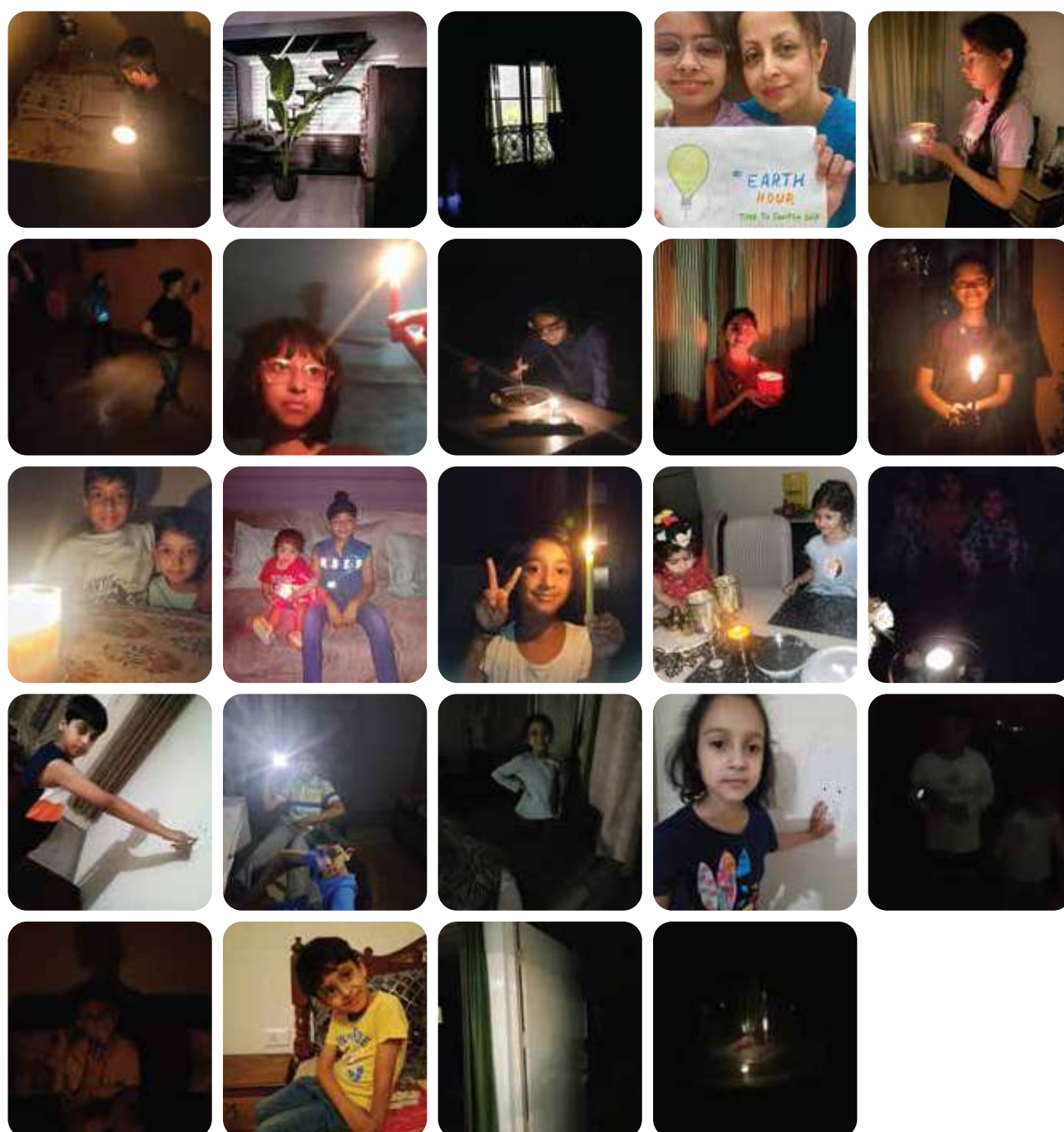
